

Ours is a holistic culture of excellence in which all contribute.



We are the only International British School in the area that follows the full British Curriculum from the age of 3 to 18. FACILITIES

Students share the ensuite accommodation with one other student in twin rooms. The rooms are all equipped with a modern bathroom, individually climate-controlled heating and air conditioning systems, Wifi, fitted wardrobes, desks, chest of drawers and all the conveniences of a typical bedroom. Views from each bedroom are stunning with all rooms equipped with either a view of the sea or the neighbouring golf course. Bedding and towels are supplied and washed by the Boarding House.



All rooms contain the following:

- Air conditioning
- Central heating
- Private bathroom with shower
- Study area
- Two closets
- A double desk with chairs
- A single bed

Each floor is accessible by elevator, and some rooms are adapted for people with physical disabilities. All room rates include wireless internet, library, swimming pool and gym access.






TAKING CARE OF OUR STUDENTS

Pastoral Care

The School's excellent pastoral care is the backbone of our boarding. Our aim above all is to ensure our students are happy within our community. Students' tutors, their housemasters and the house monitors form strong relationships with families. All of our boarding housemasters and tutors also run activities, ensuring important continuity between the boarders' day-time and boarding experience.

SPORTS ACADEMIES



InglaBest Sports Academy aim is to inspire and motivate our students to be successful and to form free, happy, well-adjusted individuals with strong values.

In our sports academy, we emphasize values such as effort, humility, tolerance, patience, respect, integrity, discipline, and commitment. All these values are fundamental aspects in physical and mental preparation: "*Mens sana in corpore sano*"

Sage College inspires students to find their unique talents to be the best they can be. As part of this development, and alongside a bespoke curriculum of education, we encourage our boarders to embrace an optional after school sports program which we have developed with elite local sport clubs.

At Sage College, we have created a unique opportunity for International students to develop their sports abilities. We have selected the three main sports in which Spain marks the difference internationally: **Football, Tennis, and Golf**, and have established links with the best local sport clubs in the area for Sage Boarders to participate in them. There are two leagues established: Junior and Elite Leagues, so they can grow in their abilities and move on to competing in championships with the local teams and clubs. Practicing sports with local Spanish teams will allow our students to meet other local athletes immersing themselves in the Spanish language and local culture.

TENNIS ACADEMY

We are proud to offer a leading tennis programme. We offer world-class tennis alongside a sound British Curriculum Programme in sunny Spain. The objective of the program is to maximize the potential of each player in a high performance club where they can combine tennis activity with excellence in studies. FOOTBALL ACADEMY

Inglabest is in partnership with local elite Football Clubs. Our boarding students can be immersed in the world of Spanish football league teams. Each pupil would be part of a Football development programme led by their elite coaching staff.

Whether you have already played in a Professional Academy, with aspirations to play professionally, or simply wish to develop your footballing ability, the programme is designed to develop players, so that they can fulfil their potential, with opportunities to progress at various levels within the sport.

There doesn't need to be a compromise involved between sports training and achieving an excellent education. The academic timetable at Sage College is specially designed to couple academics and sports achievements. There is a perfect blend of in-classroom and sport practise time. START AND END OF TERM TRANSPORTATION

The Boarding House offers a free transport provision to the Jerez airport at the start and end of each term. To qualify for this free transport provision you must reserve your transport arrivals and departures within a three day period. For arrivals, the three day period starts the day before the start of term and runs for two days into term time.


For departures, three day period starts two days before the end of each term and runs until the day after the end of term. Free transport cannot be offered outside of this three day period, without permission from the Head of Boarding.



ROOM PACKING UP

It should be the expectation for each Boarder to pack up their room at the end of each term. This may not always be necessary and the Head of Boarding will inform students when it is not required. Each student is allowed to keep a maximum of two boxes in storage during the holidays. If a student has a fridge, this is counted as one box.

Before leaving the Boarding House to return home, each student's room will need to be checked at least two hours before departure. In the case where a student's room is not left to a satisfactory standard or unreported damage has occurred, an additional housekeeping charge will be implemented.



BREAKFAST AND MEALS

Boarders are expected to attend breakfast, lunch, the after-school snack time and dinner at the boarding house each day and they will need to sign in at every mealtime. At all meals boarders should be dressed appropriately. Bare feet and/or pyjamas are unacceptable in the dining room at any time.

At breakfast on school days boarders should be wearing the full school uniform. If they are not wearing the correct uniform, they will be asked to return to their room to change or be provided with a secondhand item. Students are not allowed to attend school without the correct uniform.



POCKET MONEY

Each Boarder should have their own bank account, where parents can pay directly into their individual account. The recommended allowance of €30-40 per week is usually sufficient to cover all normal expenditures.

Pocket money can, if necessary, be given to the Head of Boarding who will keep it in and distribute it, as needed, during the course of the term. If a student needs a large sum of money, it should be requested a day or two in advance and the reason explained for the extra expenditures.

GENERAL RULES AND EXPECTATIONS

GENERAL RULES

1. The Boarding House buildings and property must be treated with respect and any damages reported immediately.
2. Civilised behaviour, courtesy and good manners are expected at all times. Running in the House, bad language, shouting and coarseness are unacceptable.
3. Entry into the bedroom corridor of the opposite sex is not allowed.
4. The swimming pool rules must be observed.
5. No litter is to be left around the Boarding House or grounds.
6. Electrical heating appliances, e.g. heaters, kettles etc. are not allowed.
7. Boarders are not allowed out of their rooms after bedtime.
8. Full School Uniform MUST be worn to School and all School functions.
9. Dress must be appropriate in the Boarding House. Footwear must be worn. No pyjamas may be worn at any meal.
10. No medicines are allowed to be kept in a student's room.
11. Boarders are not allowed to trespass on to private property.
12. Weapons of any kind are forbidden.
13. English is the only language to be spoken in the common areas of the House.
14. All Boarders need to have permission and have signed out before leaving the House.
15. Two or more people must always be in the gym when it is being used.
16. All students must return to the House by the set curfew time.

OTHER

Prep

1. All students must be quiet during Prep.
2. If homework is completed, pupils are expected to complete some additional language learning or to read a book.

Rooms

1. Beds will be made and dorms will be left tidy each morning.
2. Windows are to be opened in the morning and the air conditioning or heating turned off.

Eating

1. Table manners must be of a high standard.
2. Attendance at meals is compulsory. Boarders may miss a meal only if the Head of Boarding has given permission.

Activities

1. All students should take part in the boarding school activities
2. The weekend activities are optional for A-LEVEL students.

Relationships

1. Students are not allowed any affectionate physical contact. This includes sitting very closely together, hugging, and kissing.
2. Students in relationships should not go together to places where they are outside of general view.

Smoking, Alcohol and Drugs

1. Smoking is not allowed and no smoking materials, including electronic cigarettes, are allowed in the Boarding House.
2. Alcohol consumption and possession is not allowed in the Boarding House.
3. Illegal drug consumption and possession is not allowed. Any student found in possession of an illegal drug on School property (which includes the Boarding House) will be permanently excluded immediately from the Boarding House and the School.

Please note that Boarding students can be breathalysed for alcohol or be chosen for a drug test. Parents will always be informed of drug test results



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
