

They used different practical materials (place value counters and 'base 10' materials) and also reviewed how to represent numbers using partitioning and part-whole models. The students used **dice to create their own numbers** for different tasks. They also enjoyed some active games in the playground which helped to speed up their recall of number bonds to 100. SPANISH IN THE WORLD What do you know about "Spanish"?

Spanish is a global language that is experiencing a very significant constant growth. Did you know that it is among the top five languages in the world in the number of speakers, in the number of countries where it is official and in geographical extension? In addition, **it is the official language of the United Nations** and a reference language in international relations. Do you know how many millions of people speak Spanish?

There are almost **493 million people and it is the second mother tongue in the world** by number of speakers, and the third language in a global calculation, adding native domain, limited competence and students of Spanish, exceeding 591 million. It is also the third most used language on the net!

At Sage Co, Spanish is taught as First and Second language. In fact, more and more international students are approaching Spanish as a second language and we want to celebrate **12th October as "The Day of Respect for Cultural Diversity."**
