Children had an amazing time, enjoying the experience of being in such an incredible outdoor museum.













## SCIENCE IN Y8 Model Competition

Students in Year 8 have been learning about the circulatory system and how the structure of the heart is linked to its function. The heart has adaptations such as the left ventricle wall being thicker than the right as it has to pump blood much further around the body. Students were asked to create a 3D model that shows how oxygenated and deoxygenated blood is transported around the body. The response was absolutely magnificent as some students managed to create working systems using clear plastic tubes and dyed liquids, check out some of the fantastic finalists below.
